ORDER

This case involves the lease of a storage area network by Northrop Grumman Computing Systems, Inc. to the General Services Administration, acting on behalf of Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. The parties disagreed as to whether Northrop was entitled to be paid for the third year of the lease.
