ORDER

Xerox Corporation appealed from a deemed denial of four claims for payment on invoices totaling \$33,937.58. The claims had been submitted to a General Services Administration contracting officer in San Diego, California.

Xerox has now filed a motion to dismiss its appeal as to three of the claims, totaling \$18,385.36. It states that settlement and payment have been achieved with respect to these claims.

The unopposed motion is granted. The appeal is **DISMISSED IN PART**.

The appeal of the fourth claim, in the amount of \$15,552.22, remains before the Board.
